JAMAICAN SWIMMERS CONTINUE TO ADVANCE TO FINALS AT CENTRAL AMERICA AND CARIBBEAN SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

Jamaica's Kendese Nangle continued to be impressive and will seek to improve Jamaica's medal tally on Day II of the Central America and Caribbean Swimming Championships as she advances to two (2) finals tonight evening. Also seeking to medal will be Natasha Moodie.

Nangle swam a Personal Best in the Preliminaries of the 11-12 Girls 200M Backstroke event to take it in a time of 2:38.88. She later went on to place third in the Preliminaries of the 11-12 Girls 50M Butterfly with a time of 31.43 secs. Moodie placed fourth in the Preliminaries of the 15-17Girls 50M Butterfly with a time of 30.43 secs.
