### ***2011 NOVA SOUTHEASTERN UNIVERSITY/DAVIE NADADORES SENIOR INVITATION LONG COURSE SWIM MEET***

A 5-member delegation of the Tornadoes Swim Club will leave the island tomorrow, Friday, 14 January 2011, to compete in the annual NSU Davie Nadadores Invitational Long Course Swim Meet. The two-day competition hosted jointly by the Nova Southeastern University and the Davie Nadadores Swim Club will be held at the Nova Southeastern University Aquatics Centre, Davie, Florida, January 14-15, 2011.

This is the first in a series of overseas Meet for the Club as it seeks to expose its members to international competitions. The Meet is also being used to prepare swimmers in their quests for qualification for selection as National representatives on Jamaica's team for competitions in 2011.

The group, headed by National Senior Swimmers Timothy Wynter and Priscilla McClure also include Alexandra Beckford, D'Agaenae Clarke and Miguel Teape. Wynter and McClure have been seeded 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 200M Backstroke and 50M Breaststroke events respectively while for the other members; this is their first international competition at the senior level.
