

CCCAN SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS – DAY 2 PRELIMINARIES

Three Jamaicans advanced to the finals on day 2 of the CCCAN Championships now on in Puerto Rico. Breanna Roman finished the 15-17 girls 50m freestyle in 27.82 for fourth seed into the final; Sidrell Williams, in the 13-14 boys 50m freestyle touched in 25.47 (fifth seed) and D'Agaene Clarke made the finals in the 11-12 girls 100m freestyle in fourth position with 1:03.86.

The other swimmers this morning were Kendese Nangle in the 15-17 girls 50m freestyle (28.34), Matthew Chen in the 15-17 boys 50m freestyle (25.74), Timothy Wynter in the 13-14 boys 50m freestyle (26.53) and Antoine Young (2:24.22) and Sidrell Williams (2:29.60) in the 13-14 boys 200m butterfly.

The finals will be held later tonight.
